## Narrative

The Rockford Fire Department responded this morning to a house fire at the above address. First unit arrived within 5 minutes and reported light smoke. Firefighters stretched an attack line into the home. The fire was determined to be in the basement. The fire was quickly extinguished and damage was confined to a stove in the basement. Firefighters used fans to remove smoke from the structure. The incident was quickly controlled and downgraded. No injuries to civilians or firefighters occurred.
