### **State of Illinois Funded Road Construction Projects** **Potential Work Suspensions**

The State of Illinois has issued a letter to the City of Rockford regarding the current status of their funding source. The letter states that if the State's General Assembly fails to agree to a budget appropriating funds to the current road construction projects by June 30, 2017, work shall be suspended until an appropriations bill has passed.

The City of Rockford currently has two road construction projects underway that have joint funding with the State: *Harrison Avenue Reconstruction and North Main Street (Yonge Street to Riverside Boulevard)*. The City and State have coordinated efforts to prepare for a potential work suspension. If a work suspension is to occur after July 1<sup>st</sup>, the work zones would be stabilized, thus minimizing roadside hazards, and traffic control devices would continue to be maintained throughout the suspension. Motorists should expect to continue to follow the same detours and traffic patterns.

#### **Harrison Avenue Reconstruction Project** **(Harrison Avenue between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and East of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street)** **(11<sup>th</sup> Street between Wills Avenue and South of 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue)**

Road construction on Harrison Avenue between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 20<sup>th</sup> Street continues for the 2017 season. Currently construction crews are concentrating on the installation of underground utilities along the south lanes of the road as work is now in Stage 2 of the Harrison Avenue project. Stage 2 includes box culvert extension, road widening, new pavement, curb and gutter, medians, sidewalk, sanitary sewer construction, storm sewer installation, water main replacement, new street lights, new traffic signals, and pavement markings. Stage 2 construction is scheduled to continue through the spring and summer of 2017.

During Stage 2, the north lanes of Harrison Avenue will remain open to one lane of traffic each way at this time, with short, intermittent side street closures as the underground work moves through those intersections at various times during this stage.

Crews will be working on the completion of the 20<sup>th</sup> Street intersection and temporary ramp for the side streets on the south side of Harrison Avenue from the box culvert to the east end of the project. They will also be prepping 11<sup>th</sup> street for concrete on the west side. Concrete is expected to be poured the week of July 10<sup>th</sup>, pending any work suspension. Please follow all detours. Temporary lane closures may occur during these periods. Please expect delays.

All work is dependent on the proper weather conditions. Drivers should be aware of work zone speed limits and use caution when driving in these areas.

**Lane Closures of North Main Street (IL-2) – Illinois  
Department of Transportation Roadway Project (Yonge Street  
to just north of Riverside Boulevard)**

During the week of July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017, roadway removal work is underway south of the railroad tracks and pavement removals are underway north of the railroad tracks. Curb work and bike path construction work will be starting behind edge of pavement on the west and east side of N Main. Please be alert for construction activities when driving/Biking/Walking through these areas in the coming weeks. *The scheduled traffic lane switch over is set for July 5<sup>th</sup>. Traffic will be staged on the newly paved west lanes for the duration of the 2017 construction season. This switchover will happen with or without a July 1<sup>st</sup> IDOT shut down of construction operations.*

The southbound lanes of North Main Street between Auburn Street and Pierce Avenue will continually be shut down for roadway milling and paving operations for the length of the project until further notice. Southbound and northbound traffic will be two lane traffic for the duration of this work. In addition, western legs of North Main intersections, including: Younge Street, Wagner Avenue, Burton Street, Custer Avenue, VanWie Avenue, Fulton Avenue, Ford Avenue and Eddy Avenue, will be closed for the duration of traffic staging 2A. This work is anticipated to be completed by the end of July. The northbound lanes of North Main Street between Pierce Avenue and River Bluff will be closed for pavement removal and underground utility relocation work. This closure is anticipated to last for the remainder of the 2017 construction season, unless otherwise notified.

**Please note that businesses are open during construction.**

On March 22nd, 2017 construction began on the IDOT N Main project. The North Main Street Roadway Project consists of pavement removal, excavation, roadway re-alignment,

PCC pavement, HMA pavement, curb and gutter, landscaped median, multi-use path and sidewalk construction, water main replacement, storm sewer installation, landscaping, street lighting, traffic signal modernization and interconnection, pavement markings, erosion control, maintenance of traffic and all other necessary items to complete the improvements.

If discolored water occurs, it is not a health hazard. However, during any flushing procedures, iron (red water) and manganese (black water) may become stirred up within the water main, which can create staining on the porcelain and laundry. This work may result in the disturbance of sediment, possibly containing lead. It is advised that you flush your water lines for 1 – 2 minutes once work is completed in your area including removing and cleaning faucet aerator screens to remove sediment. The operation is dependent on existing weather conditions and is subject to change accordingly.

City-wide pavement striping for lane lines will continue during the months of May thru August.

Citizens are urged to approach striping crews at a reduced speed that is below posted speed limits. Proceed with caution traveling into the lane adjacent to the pavement striper and maintain a safe distance. Changing lanes in close proximity to the pavement striping crew is not recommended. Recent changes in EPA Regulations have mandated that manufacturers remove solvent based driers from striping paint, thus creating extended drying times. Your cooperation is appreciated.
