Narrative

The Rockford Fire Department responded to the intersection of Charles Street and Lexington Way for a vehicle rollover accident with a person trapped. Engine 11 arrived on scene first and found a vehicle on its roof with heavy front end damage and one person trapped. Firefighters worked diligently to extricate the driver from the vehicle. Extrication operations took 19 minutes from when crews first arrived on scene. The driver was transported to OSF St. Anthony Emergency room with what appeared to be minor and non-life threatening injuries. There were no firefighter injuries. The Rockford Police Department and ComEd also responded to the scene.
