Rockford Fire Announces RAMM Scholarship Call for Applications

ROCKFORD, Ill. – The Rockford Fire Department, in partnership with Rockford Area Minority Management (RAMM) has opened its online application process for the Rockford Fire/RAMM Scholarship.

The Rockford Fire/RAMM scholarship was established in 2016 to assist minority students in pursuing studies and career in fire service. The inaugural scholarship was awarded to Rockford East High School Senior, Kenneth Fuzzell-Partee, who is currently in his second year at Tennessee State University.

Interested students must be an African-American high school senior currently enrolled in a Winnebago County school with a minimum grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale. Seniors must be planning to attend an accredited 2-year junior college or 4-year college or university, and entering into a career in the fire service, fire protection or prevention.
