Weatherization will save you money by reducing the amount of energy that is used by your home. Using less energy will reduce utility bills, increase the comfort in your home, and improve indoor air quality.

Free Upgrades MAY Include

- Attic, Wall, or Basement Insulation
- Door Sweeps/Weather Stripping
- Window Air Sealing/Caulking
- Fridge/Freezer Replacement /LED Bulbs
- Faucet Aerators/Shower Heads
- Furnace Repair/Replacement
- Programmable Thermostats
- Continuous Ventilation Fan
- Air Conditioning Replacement

What We DON'T Do

- Remodel your home
- Clean your gutters or paint
- Landscaping or garden work
- Plumbing/Electrical work
- Replace cabinets
- Replace doors or windows
- Install wheelchair ramps
- Replace your roof
- Install Siding

Income eligible households with high heating bills, in relation to income, and those with elderly members (60 and over) with a disability or young children (5 or below) will be given priority and Weatherization Services first. Non-priority, income eligible households will be serviced if funding is available. Therefore, some eligible households may not receive Weatherization assistance during the program year they apply.

During your Weatherization application appointment, you will need to provide the following documents:

1. Social Security cards for **ALL** household members
2. Illinois picture ID for **ALL** adults in the household
3. Proof of gross income for the last 12 months for **ALL** household members over 18 (including un-employment, child support , etc.)
4. Monthly SSA or SSI statement for current year
5. W2's from previous year for **ALL** household members over 18
6. Proof of Home Ownership (contract-to-own **MUST** be notarized and recorded)
7. Current utility bills
