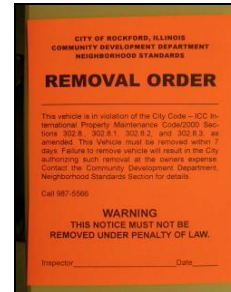


The City of Rockford Code Enforcement Division would like to inform all residents and property owners to be aware of these property maintenance issues within the community:

## Vehicles – Parking/Storage \*\$25 citation\*

- Total number of motor vehicles shall be limited to four (4) for each dwelling unit.
- All motor vehicles shall be **operable** and have **current license plates displayed**. Failure to correct this violation may result in the City's removal of the vehicle from the property.



- Autos, motorcycles, vans and trucks with passenger car or "B" plates **must be parked on a paved surface** in side and rear yards and must be parked in a driveway in front yards.
- Motor homes, campers, travel trailers and boats up to 30 ft in length, must be stored in side or rear yards **on a paved surface**. No motor home, camper, or travel trailer may be stored in any area located between the front property line and the street facing wall of the residential building (Side yard storage must be a minimum of 6 ft from the property line). RV's may not be used for residential purposes.



- All other trailers are prohibited. (Example: Utility Trailers, Box Type Trailers, Commercial Trailers, Car Trailers, etc.)

## Sanitation

- All exterior property and premises shall be maintained in a clean, safe, and sanitary condition and free from any accumulation of rubbish, garbage, brush, or material.
- Owner/Occupants shall keep that part of the exterior property in which the owner/occupant occupies or controls in a clean and sanitary condition.

## Garbage Pick-up

- Place your garbage/ bulk items out for weekly collection no sooner than 3 pm the day before scheduled pick-up and no later than 6 am the day of.
- Remove any containers no later than 8 am the day after the pick-up and store them in an inconspicuous location out of view from the street.
- A standard fee is applied for excessive amounts of garbage/bulk items exceeding 1 truck hopper. Please contact Rock River Disposal for more information 815-965-2489
- Yard Waste is collected seasonally at unlimited quantity. Yard Waste must be in 2 ply paper containers or a garbage can marked with an "X". Limbs and branches cut to 4 feet in length can be bundled with twine. Bundles must be less than 2 feet in diameter and weigh no more than 50 pounds

## Electronic Products, Tires and Household Hazardous Waste

- Rockford residents may drop off TVs, computer monitors, and other electronics that are to be recycled and Keep Northern Illinois Beautiful's Rockford Recycling Center, located at 4665 Hydraulic Road in Rockford from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Tuesdays and 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Saturdays.
- Small electronics (less than 2' x 2' and no TVs or computer monitors) may be placed in blue 32 gallon recycling bins
- Household Hazardous Wastes and up to 4 used tires may be dropped off at 3333 Kishwaukee St. on Saturday's from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Sunday's from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.



## Tall Grass and Weeds

All premises and exterior property not improved with a structure and greater than one (1) acre in size shall be maintained free from weeds or plant growth in excess of 10 inches in height. All other premises and exterior property shall be maintained free from weeds or plant growth in excess of 8 inches in height. (Does not include trees, shrubs, cultivated crops, flowers and gardens.) All noxious weeds are prohibited.
