STREET SWEEPING

Rockford, IL- Arterial Sweeping was completed for the spring cycle on April 19, 2019. The Central Business District will swept again for the sixth cycle on Thursday, June 13, 2019, during the overnight hours.

The spring Residential Street Sweeping began on April 1, 2019, and will continue through an anticipated completion of mid to late June 2019.

During the week of June 10, 2019, street sweepers will be operating in the following areas:

City Limits east to the River – Simpson Road north to Cunningham Road
N Alpine Road east to N Mulford Road – Spring Creek Road north to E Riverside Blvd





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
Spring 2019 Street Sweeping Detail

Customers are advised that they may experience discolored water during hydrant flushing. While not a health hazard, iron (red water) or manganese (black water) may become stirred up within the main while flushing which may create staining on porcelain and laundry. This may result in the disturbance of sediment, possibly containing lead. It is advised that you flush your water lines for one to two minutes once work is completed in your area, including removing and cleaning faucet aerator screens to remove sediment. For this reason, it is vital that the public be aware of the time and area that will be affected.

N GARDINER AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT
(FROM GUILFORD ROAD TO RURAL STREET)

Rockford, IL- N Gardiner Avenue from Guilford Road to Rural Street continues to be closed to through traffic so that water main installation may occur. Please note that access to residential homes will be maintained. The project is anticipated to be completed mid-June 2019.

The N Gardiner Avenue Water Main Replacement Project consists of replacing a ninety year old six inch diameter water main with an eight inch diameter water main, water services, and all associated appurtenances.

All work is dependent on the proper weather conditions. Drivers are reminded to obey work zone speed limits and to stay alert for workers when driving through the construction zone.

23RD STREET WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT
(FROM BROADWAY STREET TO 16TH AVENUE)

Rockford, IL- 23rd Street from Broadway Street to 16th Avenue continues to be closed to through traffic so that water main installation may occur. Please note that access to residential homes will be maintained. The project is anticipated to be completed mid-June 2019.

The 23rd Street Water Main Replacement Project consists of replacing ninety year old six inch diameter water main with an eight inch diameter water main, water services, and all associated appurtenances.

All work is dependent on the proper weather conditions. Drivers are reminded to obey work zone speed limits and to stay alert for workers when driving through the construction zone.

WENTWORTH TOWER REHABILITATION
(2310 WENTWORTH AVENUE)

Rockford, IL- Maintenance activities continue to progress to rehabilitate the water tower at 2310 Wentworth Avenue. The project is anticipated to be completed early December 2019.

The Wentworth Tower Rehabilitation Project consists of abrasive blasting and recoating of the interior wet, interior dry and exterior of the tank, ladder and catwalk improvements, as well as other various upgrades and improvements.

BRUCE STREET AND LAPP COURT WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT
(FROM KILBURN AVENUE TO N HORSEMAN STREET)

Rockford, IL- Lapp Court from Kilburn Avenue to N Horseman Street is closed to through traffic so that water main installation may occur. Please note that access to residential homes will be maintained. This water main project is anticipated to be completed by early July 2019.

The Bruce Street and Lapp Court Water Main Replacement project consists of replacing a one hundred five year old, six inch diameter water main with an eight inch diameter water main, water services, and all associated appurtenances. This replacement project is being completed in conjunction with the Neighborhood Program – 2018 City Wide No. 3.

All work is dependent on the proper weather conditions. Drivers are reminded to obey work zone speed limits and to stay alert for workers when driving through the construction zone.

ENGINEERING DIVISION MAINTENANCE UPDATE

IDOT PROJECT LANE CLOSURES AND UPDATE

N MAIN STREET (IL 2) –

PIERCE AVENUE TO CAMPUS HILLS BOULEVARD

Rockford, IL- The outside lanes in both directions of N Main Street between Peirce Avenue to Campus Hills Boulevard remains closed. These closures are in place for the landscape contractor to complete landscape restoration behind the curb and sidewalk. IDOT apologizes for the delay and is working with the contractor to complete the remaining construction items as soon as possible.

We ask that all drivers slow down and take extra precautions when traveling through the work zone to protect construction workers, emergency responders, other motorists, as well as themselves. Please expect delays throughout the construction zone and consider alternate routes for the duration of the project. Weather permitting, total completion for the project is scheduled for early summer 2019.

IDOT and the City will be coordinating with all applicable governmental agencies throughout the project.

IDOT PROJECT UPDATE

S MAIN STREET (IL 2) AND US BYPASS 20 INTERCHANGE

Rockford, IL- The Illinois Department of Transportation continues with the reconstruction of US 20 and Illinois Route 2 Interchange. Please be aware of changes in traffic patterns as work progresses throughout the construction season.

To allow continued traffic movement, flaggers will be in place as needed for crossovers, detours, and lane reductions. This project is estimated to be completed by October 30, 2020. Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for travel through this

area. When feasible, drivers are encouraged to consider alternate routes. Motorists are reminded to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices, as well as be alert for construction workers and equipment.

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORK- William Charles Construction will be reconstructing US 20 and IL 2 with new Portland Cement Concrete pavement and shoulders. The dual structures carrying US 20 over IL 2 will be removed and replaced. The existing cloverleaf interchange will be configured as a diamond interchange with new signal installations at the ramp intersections with IL 2. The cost of the project is \$24 million.

ROAD CLOSURE
KEITH CREEK BANK STABILIZATION AND BRIDGE REMOVAL
PHASE I & II - CONSTRUCTION

Rockford, IL- The reconstruction of Keith Creek Phase I continues to progress. Construction is on schedule to meet the completion deadline for Phase I of the project. The intersection of 5th Street and 7th Avenue is now open to local traffic until further notice. There are a few remaining items for completion of Phase I. Construction on the second phase of the Keith Creek Project continues between 7th Street and 8th Street along the creek. All work is anticipated to be completed within Keith Creek; therefore, traffic through this area should not be affected. The completion date for Phase II is anticipated for August 2, 2019.

The scope of Phase I is from 5th Street to 7th Street along Keith Creek. The project consists of removing the bridge at 5th Street over the creek, reconstructing the 5th Street and 7th Avenue intersection, reinforcing the banks with sheet piling in certain areas, as well as reshaping and stabilizing the creek banks. Please be advised that the 5th Street Bridge has been permanently removed. Phase I is scheduled for completion by the end of June 2019. Phase II project limits are from 7th Street to Railroad Avenue along Keith Creek. The scope of work is the same as Phase I with some minor changes. The bridge at 8th Avenue will be permanently removed during this phase.

Please be aware of equipment and workers as well as follow all traffic control through the duration of this project.

HARTMAN STREET AND CENTER STREET RECONSTRUCTION

Rockford, IL- The reconstruction of Hartman Street and Center Street continues to progress. The contractor will be finishing blacktop driveways and parking areas this week. Parkway restoration will be complete next week.

This project consists of a total reconstruction including water main, storm sewer, and underground service replacements. The roadway is being completely replaced with new concrete, curb and gutter, as well as driveway approaches. This project is anticipated to be completed by June 14, 2019. All work is dependent on the proper weather conditions.

Drivers should be aware of work zone speed limits and use caution when driving in the construction area. The City of Rockford appreciates your continued patience and cooperation.

BLACKHAWK PARK AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION
(FROM CHRISTINA STREET TO SEMINARY STREET)

Rockford, IL- The reconstruction of Blackhawk Park Avenue continues to progress. Blackhawk Park Avenue is closed to through traffic from Christina Street east to Seminary Street for the removal of existing concrete roadway.

New asphalt pavement along with curb and gutter will be constructed. This roadwork is expected to take four to six weeks. All work is dependent on the proper weather conditions.
