

WEST side of 12th St from State St to 2nd Ave(There are only one or two occupied houses on the west side and at least one has off street parking)

EAST side of 12th St from State St for 100 ft to allow room for a fully stretched semi to make a right turn onto 12th St

NORTH and SOUTH side of 2nd Ave from 12th St west to the school bus loading/parking area

SOUTH side of 2nd Ave from 12th St east for 100 ft to allow room for trucks to turn left onto 2nd Ave as they maneuver to back into our unloading area

3. Clarification of the "One Way" signs posted on the south side of the 12th St/2nd Ave intersection. What do they refer to? Is a left turn onto eastbound 2nd Ave permitted? Will eastbound traffic be allowed from our dock on 2nd Ave?
