

SIR, WE THE MEMBERS OF SIKH TEMPLE (GSO) ROCKFORD, HAS HUMBLE REQUEST THAT WE NEED A STOP SIGN ON 3rd. AVE. (Junction Of. 3rd. Ave. & 4th. Street.) 



Sec. 16-186. - Designated areas.

- (a) There is hereby designated certain parking spaces in municipal parking lots for use by persons with disabilities.
- (b) There is hereby established certain parking places on certain portions of streets in the city as described in the schedule as set forth in the appropriate ordinance which shall be designated for parking for persons with disabilities for the purpose of allowing a person with disabilities who resides adjacent to said parking space to park. Said parking spaces shall be limited to one space no more than 25 feet in length, per qualified resident, at any one address. Said parking spaces shall be designated by erecting parking signs only in residential areas where parking is permitted, and wherever possible, shall be located adjacent to a driveway, alley, curb-cut or intersection clearance.
- (c) It is hereby established that certain parking places on private property be designated for use by persons with disabilities and shall be used for the purpose of allowing a person with disabilities to stop, stand or park in these spaces. Such parking spaces shall be provided in the locations and quantity as prescribed by the 1997 Illinois Accessibility Code and the 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design. Such parking spaces shall be designated by striping and pavement marking the parking spaces and access aisles. Additionally, signage shall be erected in conformance with the 1997 Illinois Accessibility Code and the 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design. Parking signs designating these spaces shall be in conformance with Sec. 16-189 of this ordinance.

Sec. 16-187. - Application for residential parking space.

Any person desiring a designated residential parking space for persons with disabilities shall apply to the finance director of the city. The applicant shall submit proof of residency in the form of a valid state driver's license or identification card or a voter's identification card. The applicant shall submit proof of disabled status in the form of a certificate that he has been issued a state handicapped or disabled veteran license plates, or a state handicapped parking decal for persons with disabilities or device. There shall be a one-time initial fee in the amount established by the city, payable upon approval of the application. The finance director and traffic engineer shall and are hereby authorized to review all designated residential handicapped parking spaces annually to confirm continued eligibility.

Sec. 16-188. - Violation.

- (a) When signs are erected or pavement painted giving notice thereof, it shall be unlawful for any owner or operator of any motor vehicle to stop, stand or park, or cause to stop, stand or park in a parking area designated for use by persons with disabilities. A parking area designated for use by persons with disabilities includes, but is not limited to, parking in an access aisle adjacent to a handicapped parking stall. Upon satisfactory proof shown to the hearing officer that the owner or operator of the motor vehicle had been issued at the time of the occurrence a valid, current person with disabilities or disabled veteran license plates, or a valid parking placard, decal or device for persons with disabilities, the hearing officer shall fine the owner or operator of the motor vehicle in accordance with a violation of subsection (b) or (c) of this section and the penalty set forth in subsection 16-131(b), if applicable.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any owner or operator of any motor vehicle to stop, stand or park, or cause to stop, stand or park in a parking area designated for use by persons with disabilities in a vehicle which does not have a properly displayed, current, valid person with disabilities or disabled veteran license plates, or a valid parking placard, decal or device for persons with disabilities. A parking placard, decal or device is properly displayed in a vehicle when the decal or device is clearly visible to law enforcement or parking enforcement personnel, either hanging from the rear view mirror or placed on the dashboard of the vehicle in clear view.
- (c) The owner or operator of a private building, parking structure or parking lot where parking spaces are required by Sec 16-186 shall ensure the appropriate quantity, location and size of parking spaces are provided. The owner or operator of a private building, parking structure or parking lot where parking spaces are required by Sec 16-186 shall further ensure that all required signage is in place in conformance with the 1997 Illinois Accessibility Code and the 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design and this ordinance. A violation of these provisions and this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$750.00 for each day the designated parking areas have not been corrected.
- (d) The owner or operator of a private building, parking structure or parking lot where spaces are designated in conformance with Sec 16-186 of this ordinance is authorized to notify the Rockford Police Department when a vehicle is parked in violation of this ordinance. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the authority of the owner or operator of a private building, parking structure or parking lot to erect signage stipulating vehicles found to be parked in violation of this ordinance may be towed at the owner's expense. Such signage shall be located at the entrance to the designated parking area and immediately adjacent to spaces designated for parking by vehicles bearing state disability license plates, or disabled veteran license plates, state parking decal, or device placed in clear view hung from the rear view mirror or placed on the dashboard for persons with disabilities.

Sec. 16-189. ~~— Accessible Parking Signs Handicapped Parking Signs.~~

The owner or occupant of any property upon which is displayed any ~~handicapped signage for the express designation of Accessible parking areas signs~~, which exhibits, or is required to exhibit, the words "\$100 Fine," shall correct such sign to exhibit the words "\$250 Fine" instead. Correction of the fine amount must be completed within 90 days of the effective date of Ordinance No. 2006-170-O. A violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$750.00 for each day the ~~handicapped designated accessible~~ parking sign has not been corrected.
