I spoke with Randy Dunaway who lives at 402 Stanley St (61102) (815-964-8036) who is concerned about an accident that took place at the intersection of Stanley Street & Green Street yesterday. He commented that both cars rolled over and that there were children in one of the cars. Currently, there are yield signs on Green Street. He asked about evaluating the intersection for the possibility of the replacing the yield signs with stop signs. (This would maintain the 2-way control.) I informed him that we will get this on the July traffic commission. I told him that he is welcome to come to the meeting and he asked that I send him the meeting information so I will email that to him.

Please note that the accident of 6/16/19 may or may not be shown in the accident information before the meeting. It does appear that there have been other accidents there with the 5-yr timeframe.



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

As Secretary of the Timbercreek Homeowners Association {North portion of Tanglewood Lane}, you cannot know how 'shocked' we were to receive notice of a request to restrict parking on all of Tanglewood Lane North of Spring Creek Road. This very short section of Tanglewood Lane is used by service vehicles parking for lawn services, utility services [plumbing, electrical, television, home repair, ...] and all important services needed at one time or other throughout the year serving the 8 neighbors living on this Lane. To that end, we have been very pleased how this very short street is maintained by the City of Rockford.

In addition, neighbors occasionally have more guests than their drive can accommodate; thus, it is good to know we have approximately 8-10 spots for cars to park on the West side of Tanglewood Lane if their driveway cannot accommodate everyone. These occasions are infrequent and, as secretary of the Association, I know all our neighbors are aware of Lane parking with respect to the neighborhood {I have discussed this individually with everyone}.

I wish I could attend the August 14 meeting but will be hosting a family reunion at our northern Wisconsin lake property. I have encouraged all neighbors to attend the meeting on August 14; I hope it proves to show how we are willing to work together for the good of the neighborhood.

The enclosed Survey Form also has a **map drawn on the backside that shows the location of the 8 houses on Tanglewood Lane and the very short distance for parking on Tanglewood Lane when the occasional situation arrises for service vehicles and guests visiting.**





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
