



As Secretary of the Timbercreek Homeowners Association {North portion of Tanglewood Lane}, you cannot know how 'shocked' we were to receive notice of a request to restrict parking on all of Tanglewood Lane North of Spring Creek Road. This very short section of Tanglewood Lane is used by service vehicles parking for lawn services, utility services [plumbing, electrical, television, home repair, ...] and all important services needed at one time or other throughout the year serving the 8 neighbors living on this Lane. To that end, we have been very pleased how this very short street is maintained by the City of Rockford.

In addition, neighbors occasionally have more guests than their drive can accommodate; thus, it is good to know we have approximately 8-10 spots for cars to park on the West side of Tanglewood Lane if their driveway cannot accommodate everyone. These occasions are infrequent and, as secretary of the Association, I know all our neighbors are aware of Lane parking with respect to the neighborhood {I have discussed this individually with everyone}.

I wish I could attend the August 14 meeting but will be hosting a family reunion at our northern Wisconsin lake property. I have encouraged all neighbors to attend the meeting on August 14; I hope it proves to show how we are willing to work together for the good of the neighborhood.

The enclosed Survey Form also has a **map drawn on the backside that shows the location of the 8 houses on Tanglewood Lane and the very short distance for parking on Tanglewood Lane when the occasional situation arrises for service vehicles and guests visiting.**





To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Liliana Huerta and I live at 219 Dougherty Place, Rockford, Il 61107. I rent the upstairs (219) from the owner of 217 Dougherty Place. Recently on Sunday, August 25, 2019 I came home to a letter from the City of Rockford. This letter was to inform the resident of 219 Dougherty Place, myself and my family, that there was a "...request to establish 'No Parking Any Time' on both sides of Dougherty Place from Crosby Street to the end of the road to the south." Attached was a survey for the neighborhood to respond with their vote to keep our system the same or to add these signs. My first thought was, "Where will I park?" 219 Dougherty Place's only parking is in the street in front of our steps. We also noticed that very same night that the "No Parking Any Time" signs had already been moved to our electricity pole. The next morning, we promptly called the number listed on the letter that we had received. My mother and I talked on the phone with a Ms. Rachel Benson, who listened to our situation. We also informed her that the signs had already been moved and asked if we could still park there since a decision has not yet been made. She responded that she was not aware that the signs were already put up. As a result, August 29, 2019 I received a ticket for parking in our only parking space. My family and I have always been very courteous and understanding that we are not the only house on this part of our street. My family and I cannot afford getting a ticket every day just for parking in front of our apartment. We make sure to stay parked as close to the curb as possible and to always leave room for other cars to pass to reach the two houses in front of us knowing that while they may not have use to park in our street, they do occasionally get rides. The only time that we may block their access was once this past 2018 winter when the City snowplows came to our street and only cleared enough snow for us to park in. Our street rarely gets plowed in the winter and when they do plow, it is never more than a narrow strip. When the neighbors complained we tried to explain that it was not our fault that the City only cleaned a narrow strip and that we had no other place to park. We then shoveled part of the road in an effort to give access to both sides of the road. When we saw that this would not help, we were able to get a truck with a snow plow to give us better parking space and we even cleaned up to the end of the dead end to help our neighbors.

In the alley behind our apartment there is concrete where 217 Dougherty Place parks. We do not get access to park in this space since it is the owners. We have, on occasion, parked in front of 217 Dougherty Place's garage, but the City has let us know that this is not where we should be parking every day. 219 Dougherty Place's only possible parking is on the street in front of our steps. If we would have to park on Crosby Street instead, we would have to park very far away, because Crosby can get very crowded with cars. We also regularly have our young family members with us which could be difficult in the winter time if there is only one adult with the children and we must walk with them down Crosby and all the way up Dougherty Place to our apartment. Though we only usually park two cars at most, we understand that when we park three cars on the street in front of our steps, we occasionally hinder the driveway in front of us, but we always move when asked. We can fit two cars in front of our steps as long as the neighbors have not moved their trash cans in our parking spot like they have in the past. The



neighbors complain that their rides can never park in front of their houses, but they always have their trash cans in the middle of the street blocking access to their own homes. They also put the trash cans on the other side of our cars to block the street and they also put them by our trash cans and have even thrown their loose trash all over our cement where we have our trash cans. We try to be courteous of our neighbors, but they do not do the same for us. In a demonstration of this, they are now trying to take our only parking. We vote to keep our parking as it is.

Hello Kevin,

I have been tasked by the SHOA (Springbrook Home Owners Association) to contact you and formally ask if we can get a traffic study done in order to slow and/or deter traffic down on Spring Brook Rd. We feel upgrading to a three way a stop sign at Shaw Woods and Spring Brook (Right by Fire House) would be good solution although we are willing to listen to others.

We use Spring Brook Road and live in Spring Brook Homeowners Association and have noticed an increase in both number of cars and the speed at which they drive over the years to where it now has reached dangerous levels. I have informally talked to homeowners along the section between Mulford and Spring Creek Rd and formally at our monthly homeowners meeting. It is unanimous that people are not happy with the amount and speed of traffic on this 30 mph section. It also is a main E-W route for bikes and runners to connect with Perryville Path.

I have even talked to the Fire house behind me and they said that they have to wait sometimes to enter Spring Brook as traffic is a problem with speeding traffic.







Vehicle Counts Vs. Speed [Spring Brook Road Speed Study: Merged]



Percentile Counts Vs. Speed for [Spring Brook Road Speed Study: Merged]


