



Essential Services During the Stay at Home Order

From the Governor's Order, these essential businesses and operations may continue during the Stay at Home Order:

- Government, including police, fire and 911
- Health care facilities and public health care operations
- Stores that sell groceries
- Pharmacies
- Medical and adult use cannabis dispensaries and operations
- Food production and agriculture
- Organizations that provide charitable and social services
- Human services operations
- Media
- Gas stations and auto supply/service
- Financial institutions
- Hardware and supply stores
- Critical trades and essential infrastructure
- Mail, post, shipping, logistics and delivery services
- Educational institutions (for the purposes of facilitating distance learning)
- Laundry services
- Restaurants for off-premises consumption
- Supplies to work from home
- Supplies for essential businesses and operations
- Transportation (bus, taxi, Uber, Lyft)
- Home-based care and services
- Residential facilities and shelters
- Professional services (legal, accounting, insurance, real estate)
- Certain day care centers for employees exempted by this order
- Manufacturing, distribution and supply chain for critical products and industries
- Critical labor union functions
- Hotels and motels
- Funeral services
